# **2018 NATIONAL CONTEST – CATEGORY NOTES**

## PAPERS by May 15th

You need to submit your project to the NHD national office in two different formats:

(1) *Upload a PDF copy of your paper* when you register online according to the instructions posted here:

(2) Mail four copies of your paper to this address:

You need to complete <u>both</u> of the submission methods above by May 15 in order for your project to be considered by the judges at the National Contest.

## WEBSITES by May 15th

Publish your website through the NHD Website Editor before 11:59pm EDT (that's one hour earlier than Wisconsin time) on Tuesday, May 15. After the deadline has passed, you will be locked out of editing.

### **PERFORMANCES**

Bring <u>at least 8 copies</u> of your process paper and bibliography. If you qualify for a Final Round, you will need them all.

Pack a repair kit with safety pins, needles, thread, tape, glue, and whatever else you might need to fix damage to your props and costumes.

#### **DOCUMENTARIES**

Bring at least 8 copies of your process paper and bibliography. If you qualify for a Final Round, you will need them all.

**Burn a DVD of your project** and test it on a DVD player, not a computer, before you leave Wisconsin. Then bring as many backup formats as you can, including YouTube videos, flash drive files, and laptops with connection cables. **Bring at least two formats to the National Contest. Do not rely solely on internet access.** 

#### **EXHIBITS**

**Bring** <u>at least 6 copies</u> of your process paper and bibliography. Four copies will remain with your project in the Exhibit Room throughout the National Contest.

Pack a repair kit with tape, glue, paint, pens, markers, blank paper, and whatever else you might need to fix damage to your project. Only students are allowed into the Exhibit Room for set-up; adults and friends may not help set-up.

#### WHAT TIME WILL I BE JUDGED?

Students will be told their judging times when they register at the National Contest in Maryland. The earlier you visit the check-in desk in the Stamp Student Union, the earlier you'll know the answer. NHD in Wisconsin staff will not be given this information ahead of time.

Announcements about Performance and Documentary Final Rounds will be made on NHD.org and "live" in the Stamp Student Union at 7:00pm Monday for the Junior Division and at 7:00pm Tuesday for the Senior Division. The NHD National Office won't announce which projects made the Final Rounds in other categories until the end of the week.
