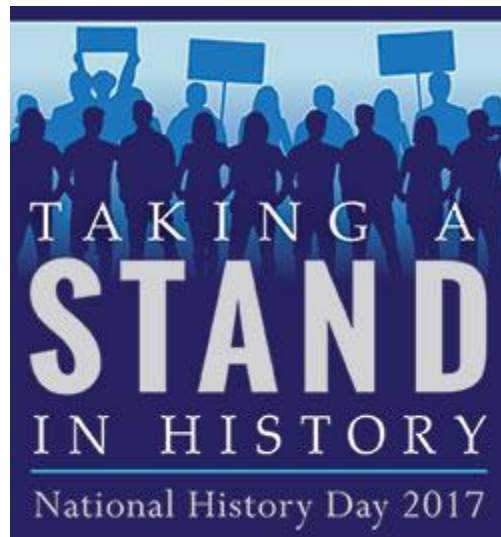

For Junior Individual and Group Exhibits, Junior Papers, Junior Individual and Junior Group Websites: Final round judging will take place without students present. Finalists will not be posted.

As soon as possible, Documentary and Performance finalists' names will be posted near the check-in area, outside the Ojibwe Ballroom (Davies Student Center, 3<sup>rd</sup> floor).

We will only post finalist names for Junior Individual and Group Documentaries, and Junior Individual Performances. These final rounds are **open to the public, starting at 6:30pm**. There are no interviews in final rounds. Documentaries and Performances will run closely together. Please plan to be in the room by 6:20pm. ***Bring two copies of your Process Paper + Bibliography.***

*Junior Documentary and Junior Individual Performance students will only have a short time from posting until **final rounds begin at 6:30pm**. Have your film or props, plus two copies of your Process Paper + Bibliography, ready to go.*

## AWARDS CEREMONY

The awards ceremony will take place in Schofield Auditorium, on the first floor of Schofield Hall). There will be two ceremonies: the first (8:00-8:20) is for Senior Division. The second (8:20-8:40) is for Junior Division. Three state finalists and one alternate will be chosen from each category and division.

# JUDGING and VIEWING OF PROJECTS

**PAPERS & WEBSITES:** Website and Paper interviews are closed to the public. Only the students being interviewed will be allowed in the competition rooms.

**DOCUMENTARIES & PERFORMANCES:** Documentaries and Performances are **open to the public**. Please do not enter or exit a room while a presentation is in progress. Doors will open during the interview and set-up times. Photos may be taken only with permission.

**Documentary students:** If your time permits, try to test your documentary. Rooms will be open from about 2:45-3:45 and during any breaks. Only students may test and play their documentaries; tech staff will be available. Bring your documentary in at least one format (DVD, flash drive, online, saved to the hard drive of a laptop). Do not rely only on a flash drive or YouTube.com. Do not rely on accessing a school's drive or network.

**Junior Individual & Group Documentaries:** Bring *two extra copies* of your Process Paper + Bibliography in case your project advances to a final round.

**Performance students:** According to NHD rules, once you enter the door to your competition room, you must carry and set-up all your props and then remove them after your interview. Adults can help carry props and costumes through the hallways.

**Junior Performances:** Bring *two extra copies* of your Process Paper + Bibliography in case your project advances to a final round.

**EXHIBITS:** During judging (4-6:10pm), only judges and Exhibit students are allowed in the Ojibwe Ballroom. A judge or room monitor will call students in for their interviews.

Exhibits will be set-up from 2:00-3:45. NHD rules require that students must carry their exhibit in from the entrance door of the room and then set-up their exhibit without adult help. Exhibit removal is from 7:00-7:45. Adults can help with exhibit removal.

The public may view Exhibits before judging begins at  
4:00 and from approximately 6:10-6:30.

# PARKING
