TEAM WISCONSIN BY BUS

Ride to Nationals in style with a large group of history lovers led by your nerdy NHD Coordinators! The NHD in Wisconsin team has pulled together an exciting plan to provide the best possible National Contest experience for our students. To start, we'll drive 36 hours together cross-country to Maryland in a coach bus, staying as a group in a residence hall at the University of Maryland - College Park. During downtime in the National Contest schedule, we'll take excursions to major museums in the Smithsonian complex, the Holocaust Memorial Museum, monuments on the National Mall, Medieval Times, and more!

FAST AND EASY

The real beauty of the Team Wisconsin Travel Package is its convenience. *Once you register for the National Contest online and submit a few forms to the Wisconsin Historical Society, you're all done!* Arrangements for your transportation, food, housing, and sightseeing are taken care of, and you'll still have free time during the trip to make additional sightseeing plans (Monday for senior division, Tuesday for junior division).

<u>ALL TRAVEL EXPENSES INCLUDED</u>

All of the incidental expenses of your trip to National Contest are included in the cost of the Team Wisconsin Travel Package, including your off-campus meals and your admission to the sightseeing venues on our schedule.

- By driving together on the coach bus, we avoid air fares and ground travel costs in the D.C. area.
- By *pre-booking all of our sightseeing activities* in advance, we benefit from discounted group rates.
- By staying in the dorms and eating in the dining halls, lower high "east coast" costs.
- If you are an **Exhibit** or a **Performance** student, bringing your project on the bus will also save you shipping. **We cannot transport materials for students who opt out of the Team Wisconsin Travel Package.**

FAMILIES WELCOME

Who can join Team Wisconsin? Students (of course), parents, teachers, siblings, friends ... just about anyone. If your family has thought about driving out to D.C., here's your chance to let someone else do the driving.

CHAPERONES NEEDED

<u>Students must have a designated chaperone</u> for the entire trip. No more than three students can be chaperoned by one adult. Chaperones can be a parent of any student on the bus, a teacher, or an adult 18 years or older.

For schools with more than one National Finalist, consider asking a teacher to be your chaperone. This might mean that you'll need to do some fundraising or pay a portion of the chaperone's travel costs; however, it's less expensive if several students share the cost of one chaperone. Ask your school if there are funds available toward this important academic activity.

MEDICAL INFORMATION

On the nhdinwi.weebly.com site download the medical information form. This form needs to be printed, filled out, and placed in a sealed envelope with the students' full name on the front. As students board the bus on June 8, this envelope will be collected by NHD and only opened if a medical emergency arises.

TEAM SPIRIT

The "Olympic Village" experience of staying and travelling with Team Wisconsin is an exciting chance to meet other hardworking students who share your interests! Get to know your fellow history lovers through seven days of shared adventuring. "Making History Since 1848!"

RIDING THE BUS

The Team Wisconsin bus is *a coach bus with wireless internet access, video screens, and one restroom*. We use the same bus for the entire trip – driving out to Maryland at the beginning, sight-seeing around D.C. during the week, and driving back to Wisconsin at the end. Bring snacks and water. We'll make stops at several (safe, clean) travel plazas, including one in Pennsylvania that has many items you never knew existed and provides for some

laughs at about 3:00am. Try regional snacks, e.g. Utz potato chips and (for the bravest) scrapple (this is a good time to use Wikipedia).

STAYING IN THE RESIDENCE HALL

Maryland is <u>hot</u> in the summer. Hot and humid. Thankfully, there is air conditioning in the dorms, but pack wisely to keep your cool. Bring a desktop-size fan (battery or corded), refillable water bottle, hat, sunscreen, and loose clothes made from lightweight fabric; even a small packable umbrella. Keep cool, Wisconsinites!

There is a bathroom in each wing of every floor. Every bathroom has 4 showers, 4 bathroom stalls, and 6-8 sinks. The bathrooms are cleaned daily, but we still recommend that you bring flip-flops for the showers.

Your dorm room will include sheets, a lightweight blanket, towels and a small pillow.

If you wish to do laundry, bring quarters and detergent (no liquids).

Bus riders may want to bring cards and small games for the bus ride and the Team Wisconsin Lounge.

The University of Maryland has a swimming pool available for about \$7/day.

If you want to have internet in the dorms or on-campus, then you will need to **pay for an internet login when you register online for the National Contest.** That login will work all week long, throughout the National Contest. Our coach bus will also have wireless internet access, but it's slow if everyone's online at the same time.

In case of a non-medical emergency on campus, you can call the Stamp Student Union at (301) 314-3375 or the 24-Hour Residence Hall Desk at (301) 314-5275. NHD in Wisconsin staff will provide our cell numbers to all riders, parents, and chaperones.

WISCONSIN SWAG

The culture of the National Contest is rooted in state pride. Team Hawaii will be festooned with floral leis. Team Minnesota will have a grown man in a moose costume. *We'll bring inflatable cows and cowbells for the glory of Team Wisconsin. The rest is on you.* If you have any cheeseheads in your closest, for example, or cow-print pants, or Badger bling, those things should absolutely come with you.

NHD BUTTONS

Every team brings its own signature buttons to the National Contest. Students trade them all week long and try to build a full set, with one button from each of the participating teams. When you board the bus, we will give you the 50 buttons that are part of the Team Wisconsin Travel Package!
