May 15	\$\$\$ DUE: Online Registration for National Contest AND Registration Fee - \$150 or \$60 All National Finalists and their teachers who are attending the National Contest, must register. If a group member will not be at the contest, he or she must still fully register and pay \$150 by the deadline in order for the group to register. Student fee: \$150. Teacher fee: \$60 Teachers please register as "Educator with Competing Student." The contest has a lot of professional development workshops! Register online at: nhd.org/register \$\$\$ DUE: Lodging/Meals Payment — about \$458 When you register for Nationals, register for lodging and select your meal plan. If you choose to eat fewer meals on campus, your cost will be less than \$458. As you will for registration, pay online with a purchase order or with a credit card. DUE: Paper and Website Projects Submit/mail/publish Paper students need to submit their projects both online and in the mail. Website students need to press "Publish" before the NHD national office locks all websites at 12:00pm ET on Wednesday, May 17

FAST AND EASY

Staying in the dorms on campus will give you fast and easy access to the contest. Public transportation options also make trips to Washington D.C. fast, easy, and affordable! The "Olympic Village" experience of staying with Team Wisconsin will be a really exciting chance to meet other hardworking students who share your interests and get to know them well!

CHAPERONES NEEDED

<u>Students must have a designated chaperone</u> for the entire trip. No more than three students can be chaperoned by one adult. Chaperones can be a parent of any student on the bus, a teacher, or an adult 18 years or older.

For schools with more than one National Finalist, consider asking a teacher to be your chaperone. This might mean that you'll need to do some fundraising or pay a portion of the chaperone's travel costs; however, it's less expensive if several students share the cost of one chaperone. Ask your school if there are funds available toward this important academic activity.

STAYING IN THE RESIDENCE HALL

Maryland is <u>hot</u> in the summer. Hot and humid. Thankfully, there is air conditioning in the dorms, but you can pack wisely to keep your cool. Bring a desktop-size fan. Bring a refillable water bottle. Bring a hat. Bring sunscreen. Bring loose clothes made from lightweight fabric.

There is a bathroom in each wing of every floor. Every bathroom has 4 showers, 4 bathroom stalls, and 6-8 sinks. The bathrooms are cleaned daily, but we still recommend that you bring flip-flops for the showers.

Your dorm room will include sheets, a lightweight blanket, towels and a small pillow.

If you wish to do laundry, bring quarters and detergent (no liquids).

The University of Maryland has a swimming pool available for about \$7/day.

If you want to have internet in the dorms or on-campus, then you will need to **pay for an internet login when you register online for the National Contest.** That login will work all week long, throughout the National Contest. Our coach bus will also have wireless internet access, but it's slow if everyone's online at the same time.

WISCONSIN SWAG
